1. Let our constituents know who you are by sending us:
 - a. Your photo
 - b. A short bio (a few sentences summarizing your career, education, where you are from, and what you love)
 - c. Your ArtSeed Statement: What you know about ArtSeed and what it means to you. Scroll down the www.artseed.org homepage for 3 examples
2. Inspire kids to try your project themselves now that they know you by providing the following:
 - a. A still image (jpeg or png) of your final artwork
 - b. Your video link (on YouTube or other site) that pertains to how that artwork was made (around 10 minutes)
 - c. A related lesson plan using the template prompts above (materials needed, vocabulary words, names and/or links to similar artists' approach, tips on how you made the piece, what activity is involved).
