


Thomas Graves, ArtSeed Presenter's Packet

Lesson #1: Title: One-Line Zen Art Date: 4/24/21 Time: 3-4 p.m. Artist: Thomas Graves Materials Prep: Pen or pencil plus any kind of paper. Introduction/Goals: Use one line drawing to simplify the complex world around us. By trusting spontaneous instinct, eliminating interruptions, and fussy details, you will experience the freedom of the one-line drawing process. **Activity:** Students will draw the first thing that comes to mind when pen or pencil touches paper and will not pick up pen or pencil until the drawing is done. **Vocabulary:** Relaxation, minimalism

Closing: Towards the end of class, students can share their artwork, hear responses, and answer any questions.

Successes: Students will find that there is no wrong approach or outcome to an art project.

Challenges: It may be difficult to remember not to lift the pen or pencil.
