Lesson: Caricature Drawing

Materials/prep: Graphite pencil, color pencils, eraser, white drawing paper

Challenges: Learning how to look and examine facial structure, become comfortable with exaggeration

Note: Caricatures do not necessarily have to be of someone known or recognizable, and can be completely made up. The idea is just to have fun!
