Lesson: Caricature Drawing

Materials/prep: graphite pencil, color pencils, eraser, white drawing paper

Introduction/goal: create a caricature using a photograph as reference

Activity: look at examples of caricature and watch a demonstration, then draw your own

Close: share your results with the other participants

Challenges: learning how to look and examine facial structure, become comfortable with exaggeration

Note: caricatures do not necessarily have to be of someone known or recognizable, and can be completely made up. The idea is just to have fun!
