French-born photographer, educator, and long-time ArtSeed friend and advisor Michelle Vignes (1926-2012) photographed major social movements. From Vietnam War protesters burning draft cards to Oakland's vibrant blues scene, her work captured important events of political and cultural change.

Michelle received ArtSeed students on field trips to her home studio. The first time she donated was when she decided to give her home and studio to ArtSeed, an incredible symbol of her confidence in our future and providing ArtSeed with our first legacy gift.

Today, May 13, is her birthday, and we are thrilled to announce our new Michelle Vignes Legacy Circle.

No matter where you are on your life's journey, making or updating your will can bring you, and the folks and causes you care about, an immense feeling of satisfaction and security. After years of looking into this and learning how easily I could clarify my own plans, I wanted you to have, with no obligation to ArtSeed, access to a free estate planning tool.

From 2013 to early 2017, Michelle's Diamond Heights home — with a library, dark room, garden, and sweeping city views — was San Francisco's only live-in artist residency offering intimate classes, readings, and art exhibition receptions for the public. When upkeep became too costly, ArtSeed sold the property to an artistic couple, allowing us to launch four years of year-round programming at Labyrinth Studios. Since then, income from the sale of Michelle's cottage has, combined with your gifts, brought mentorships and summer camps to the young and vulnerable who can't afford private instruction.

One child given serious tools and attention can change others exponentially causing the world to move towards policies that treasure all children's future. <u>Let's continue Michelle's legacy of making meaningful arts experiences possible, giving form to young peoples' unique, creative gifts.</u>
